Ms. Bhargava's academic background is equally impressive. Born in Chandigarh, India, her foundational education includes completing Standard XII (A Level Equivalent) at Bhavan Vidyalaya Senior Secondary School in 2013 and Standard X (O Level Equivalent) at St. Stephens School in 2011.

Throughout her career, Ms. Bhargava has received numerous accolades, including the Dean's Citation Award for Instructional Leadership during her MBA program and the Five Year Award for Exceptional Performance from Georgetown University. Her leadership skills were evident early on as she served as head girl at Bhavan Vidyalaya Senior Secondary School in 2012 and sports captain at St. Stephens School in 2010.

In addition to her professional accomplishments, Ms. Bhargava is actively involved in industry-related organizations. She has chaired the Human Rights Council at McKenna Model United Nations since 2014 and has held various other leadership roles within Model United Nations organizations over the years.

In her free time, Ms. Bhargava enjoys playing soccer, attending concerts, and hiking. Drawing from her own experiences navigating complex immigration issues while maintaining career progression, she empathizes with the hardships faced by immigrants in the United States.
